About the Program: The Jefferson County R-1 School District was formed in 1950 when residents in the county's growing suburbs voted to consolidate 39 small school districts into one countywide school system. The county's population in 1950 was 55,687 with a student enrollment of 9,100. Today, Jeffco has a population of more than 530,000 and student enrollment of 85,700. The district has 93 elementary, 19 middle and 17 high, seven option and 12 charter schools.
