Art Center Opens Sculpture Garden

On Sunday, Sept.25, ABA member Foothills Art Center celebrated the grand opening of its Carol and Don Dickinson Sculpture Garden with a free family picnic and garden festival. Designed by an esteemed trio of professionals — including renowned granite sculptor Jesús Moroles, landscape architect Susan Saarinen and architect Ted Schultz — the sculpture garden is a unique and artful addition to the landscape of Foothills Art Center.

The grand opening was the first opportunity for the public to see the newly installed "granite Aspens" carved specifically for this project by sculptor Jesús Moroles. The sculptures were installed and immediately covered for unveiling during the special opening weekend.

The \$300,000 Dickinson Sculpture Garden offers many benefits for Foothills Art Center and the Golden community, including increased accessibility for people of all abilities, improved safety, an enhanced and expanded area for outdoor programs and events, and the addition of another urban garden and outdoor sculpture gallery in downtown Golden.

Local organizations have truly given a "Golden seal of approval" to this project, with grants provided by the Golden Civic Foundation, the Golden Urban Renewal Authority, the Northwoodside Foundation, the Golden Economic Development Commission, Jefferson County Open Space and the Rotary Club of Golden.

Other contributors over \$5,000 include many names notable in both the Golden and regional arts communities: Nancy B.
