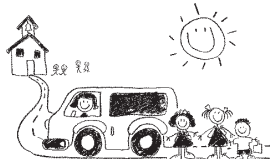
## Feed (and water) the Birds

We are aware that with the fires and drought, our bird feeders need to be kept full for our feathered friends. These same birds also might need water. If a bird bath is not an option, nail a pie pan to the top of your fence and fill it with water, or buy a good looking and tasteful portable bird bath that fastens to your fence. Available at Wild Bird Center in the Applewood Center.



## Flashing Red Means Stop

Children return to school in August. When school is in session, we must be patient and use extra care. Watch for crossing guards, school safety patrols and playground areas where children could be. Statistically, the most dangerous time for driving in and around school zones is the afternoon. Always watch for children between parked cars. Drive with headlights on, even during the daylight hours, so other drivers—and children—can see you. Remember it is illegal to pass a school bus, even in a parking lot, when the red lights are flashing. You can pass legally when the red lights are off.
