A pleasing rejuvenation to Wheat Ridge's "Main Street"

Wheat Ridge has completed the city's streetscape project along W. 38th from Sheridan to Harlan. There are now new entryway monuments at both corners of 38th and Sheridan, ornamental clocks at Sheridan, Depew and Harlan and the sidewalks are separated from the street with a five-foot lawn containing trees and new ornamental lights. Brick columns with black metal fencing are common throughout the project to conceal the visual clutter of car-filled parking lots. Patterned, colored concrete cross walks establish a clearly identifiable walking area for pedestrians.
