### REVITALIZING YOUNGFIELD

As we prepare to take on the job of Revitalizing Youngfield, the ABA needs your help and input.

The Jefferson County traffic plan for Youngfield calls for the street to be a 5-lane road from Colfax, north to 44<sup>th</sup> Ave. This would mean two north-south travel lanes plus a center turn lane. The official position of the ABA has been that Youngfield should be a 3-lane street. One lane each for north-south travel and a center turn lane.

At this time, we are re-visiting the ABA position to be certain that we are pursuing what it is that our members want.

As we move in to the design-planning phase, it will be necessary to work with consultants. We will be asking the municipalities to participate in the cost. What are your thoughts about the ABA spending some of its budget to help pay for consultants.

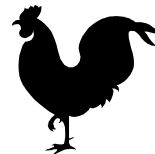
