Summer Jobs for Young Job Seekers Jeffco YouthWorks Offers Paid Internships to Eligible Youth Ages 14 to 24

Jeffco YouthWorks will begin hiring for its 2009 Summer Internship Program. It's an opportunity for youth to explore different career areas, while learning new skills and gaining work experience. The program is set to begin in June and run through August. The seven-week internship program is open to eligible young job seekers between the ages of 14 and 24. Funding for the internship program is part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Jeffco YouthWorks and local businesses are working together to create a successful internship program. The young job seekers will earn \$8 an hour and work 20 hours a week.
